

CHILD IDENTIFICATION PROCEDURES (CHILD FIND)

As a member of the Educational Service District 112 Special Education ESA, Wahkiakum School District conducts child find activities for the purpose of locating, evaluating and identifying individuals with a suspected disability who are residing within district boundaries, whether or not they are enrolled in the public school system. Child find activities apply to individuals birth through 21 years who are not currently receiving special education and related services. Parents having concerns about their child's health, hearing, intellectual functioning, language, learning, movement, serious behavioral needs, speech, or vision can contact the principal in their child's school (360-795-3261 for Julius A. Wendt Elementary/John C. Thomas Middle School, or 360-795-3271 for Wahkiakum High School) or contact the Educational Service District 112 at 1-800-233-0067.
