## Background Information

- Representative, Joel McEntire sponsored House Bill 2381
- HB 2381 authorizes OSPI to increase the number of waivers from 10 to 30 and school districts with student populations of fewer than 1,000 students qualify to apply
- Examples of Washington State school districts currently operating under the 4 Day School Week Waiver Include: Waterville (Douglas County), Selkirk (Pend Oreille County), Cusick (Pend Oreille County), PeEll (Lewis County), Paterson (Benton County), and Bickleton (Klickitat County)
